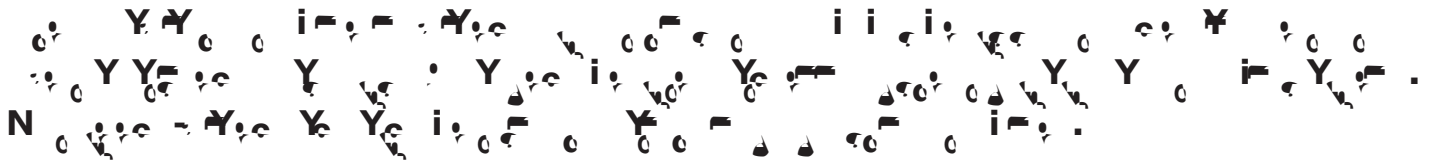

3.00–3.24	up to \$18,000 ALUMNI AWARD

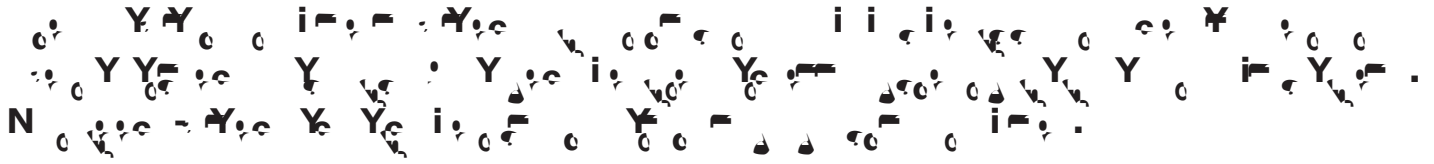

- Academically qualified Federal Pell Grant recipients from Indiana will receive grants to reduce direct costs to \$3,000 annually after utilizing Federal Loans.
- Academically qualified students from families residing in Indiana with adjusted gross incomes up to \$125,000 will receive grants to lower the Wabash tuition and fees equivalent to tuition and fees at the state's flagship university.

- WHAT:** Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID (one for the student, one for the parent)

WHY: FSA IDs are used to electronically sign the FAFSA

WHERE: Apply at <https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account>

WHEN: Due as soon as possible and is necessary to submit the FAFSA
- WHAT:** Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

WHY: To apply for eligible need-based financial assistance at the federal and state levels (including Federal Direct Student and Parent PLUS loans)

WHERE: Complete at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/>

WHEN: Please submit by February 1, 2023 for Wabash processing (State of Indiana deadline is April 15, 2024)
