Dear Parent or Guardian,

I am excited to welcome you to Wabash College and provide you with information related to your son's tuition invoice for the 2021-2022 academic year. We are providing this information now to allow you maximum time to plan. Our goal is to assist you in any way, so please feel free to contact us at any time!

Your son's fall tuition invoice will be available online at <https://webservice.wabash.edu/student> on June 15, with payment due on August 1. In order for your son to register for fall classes — and to maintain his housing preference — the tuition invoice must be in good standing. Good standing means that the payment has been made in full, or arrangements have been made for full payment through monthly payment plan payments, or loans. To be in good standing, payment plans must be current, and students must complete all the necessary loan and financial aid verification. We ask that you please help your son complete and submit all forms in a timely fashion. If your financial obligation to the College is not met, your son will not be permitted to register for fall classes or move into College housing.

Payments may be mailed to Wabash College Business Office, P.O. Box 352, Crawfordsville, IN 47933. You may also pay online using a debit or credit card, or electronic check at [www.wabash.edu/businessoffice](http://www.wabash.edu/businessoffice). If you would like an alternative to a lump-sum payment of tuition, you may enroll in the Wabash College payment plan on Wabash Self-Service by clicking on the "Student Finance" tab, clicking the "Student Finance" link, and clicking on "Payment Plan"

Please be aware that, in accordance with FERPA (Federal Education Rights and Privacy Acts), all correspondence regarding tuition invoices is directed to your son, predominantly via email. Your son should monitor his Wabash email closely. Tuition invoices are available on the Student Finance tab Wabash Self-Service. We strongly recommend that your son give you online access to his tuition invoice (we call this "person proxy") at <https://webservice.wabash.edu/student>. If your son is a fall-sport athlete, his tuition invoice must be in good standing in order to begin practicing in August.
